IMPORTANT

Students should attend classes they intend to take from the start of the semester (27th February) even before the notification of being accepted to class in the registration.

Mandatory on-line registration (more details below).

In case the student **DOES NOT SEE the registration** on his/her USOSweb profile **on Friday morning, 24 February 2017** (Note: registrations will be still NOT active but you should see it), he/she should immediately send an email with a request to activate his/her registration with his/her details (name, surname, JU ID number) to the contact person assigned to registration.

After registration make sure the course is linked to the student's programme on the day of registration! If not - you will be removed from the course on the day after registering. ('linkage' section of USOSweb profile).

Acceptance for the course:

Registration does not mean that the student is successfully registered for the class. On Monday morning (6 March) students should check their USOSweb account whether they have been accepted to the class or not.

Registration:

Acceptance into the course will be decided based on the ranking list and the time of online registration. The assigned rank determines the priority: the higher the rank the higher the possibility of being successfully accepted to the course (in the case that there are more students interested in the course than places available). Student may register for the courses providing that there is sufficient space – a maximum class size applies.

The following ranking list applies for registration: WSM.IE.EN2-16/17L:

- Rank of 6: students enrolled in the fee based MA programmes at the Centre for European Studies;
- Rank of 5: students enrolled in other European Studies international programmes (Euroculture, Padua, Strassbourg etc);
- Rank of 4: Erasmus and CEEPUS students who are on direct exchange to the Institute of European Studies.
- Rank of 3: All other students of the Institute of European Studies;
- Rank of 2: All other international students of the Jagiellonian University (including Erasmus students on exchange to other units, international students in other paid programmes);
- Rank of 1: Students who do not belong to any of the above mentioned group and would like to attend classes

The following ranking list applies for registration: WSM.IE.EN3-16/17LL

- Rank of 3: students enrolled in the MA in Euroculture Padua, Strassbourg and polish programmes at the Institute for European Studies;
- Rank of 2: Erasmus and CEEPUS students who are on direct exchange to the Institute of European Studies.
- Rank of 1: All other international students of the Jagiellonian University (including Erasmus students on exchange to other units, international students in other paid programmes);

After registration student should make sure the course is linked to the student's programme on the day of registration! If not - student will be removed from the course on the day after registering. ('linkage' section of USOSweb profile).

Withdrawal:

Students who decide not to attend a course in which they are enrolled may withdraw after the registration finishes under the condition that the Director of Institute of European Studies, dr hab. Krzysztof Koźbiał, agrees to the student's request (via written 'petition' letter). A petition with a suitable request should be submitted no later than 30 days from the day when classes has started in the semester to the CES Office at Garbarska 7a. Please be advised that NZAL (niezaliczenie = fail) will be entered in the student's records if he/she will not receive permission to withdraw and will not take the final exam.

PLEASE NOTE: courses can only be taken for credit, NOT audited. Student undertake to actively participate in class and complete the required coursework, readings and preparation, as prescribed in the course syllabus
