## YEAR AND DURATION OF STUDIES 2017/2018

### Scheduled Academic Year

The academic year is defined as running from 1 October until the following 30 September. This is the academic year which is used to determine the length of most bureaucratic procedures such as bank loans and insurance.

### Semesters

In Poland, the academic year is divided into two semesters.

<b>Autumn:</b>	2 October – 28 January	classes
	29 January – 10 February	regular exams
	17 – 23 February	re-sit exams
<b>Spring:</b>	24 February – 15 June	classes
	16 – 29 June	regular exams
	1 – 15 September	re-sit exams

### Jagiellonian University academic holidays

On academic holidays, there are no classes or examinations. The main University offices are usually closed. Those offices that are open operate with reduced hours and staff. Instructors are usually unavailable for consultation during academic holidays.

### Pre-semester 2017

- **15 - 18 September 2017:** Advised arrival for students wishing to rent a flat.

- **Mid- October 2017:** Election of Student Representatives for 2017/18\*
- **15 – 31 October 2017:** Second-year students may renew their *legitymacja* (student ID) for the autumn semester by submitting it to the administration office
- **30 October – 3 November 2017 –** Study trip to Poland and Germany for SA and BA students (covered by tuition fees)
- **11 November 2017:** Independence Day – no classes at University
- **22 December 2017:** Last day of BA-level classes before Christmas break

- **30 March- 3 April 2018** – Easter Holiday break, no classes
  - **End of April (TBC):** Study trip\*
  - **1 - 3 May 2018:** May Day, Constitution Day – no classes at the University
  - **mid-May 2018:** Juwenalia (Student carnival – no classes on Friday)
  - **15 June 2018:** Last day of spring classes
  - **16 – 29 June 2018:** Final examination period
